The HCCA submits sessions deemed eligible for general CLE credits to most states with CLE approval processes for sponsors. Exceptions are noted below. CLE credits are awarded based on state CLE rules and individual attendance. Please note that approvals will vary as each state may have different CLE requirements, rules, and regulations:

⚠️ Not every state will approve a virtual format, or there may be insufficient time to meet the prerequisites for approval of virtual sponsor status before this event.

⚠️ Not every state calculates CLE credits based on the clock (60-minute) hour.

⚠️ Not every state will grant general CLE credits for all sessions submitted by the HCCA.
