**WHEREAS**, Dallas County Hospital District d/b/a Parkland Health & Hospital System (“Parkland”) has a long tradition of integrity, responsible conduct, and commitment of service to the medical and social needs of the community entrusted to its care in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, guidelines and professionally recognized standards of care; and

**WHEREAS**, effective May 30, 2013, Parkland entered into a five year Corporate Integrity Agreement (the “CIA”) with the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of Health and Human Services (the “OIG”) and is in the process of compiling its final Annual Report for submission to the OIG; and

**WHEREAS**, Parkland acknowledges the challenges it has faced and understands that it must continue to advance the principles of compliance, ethics, quality of care and patient safety within the organization; and

**WHEREAS**, as it moves beyond the term of the CIA, Parkland is focused on sustainability and continued enhancement of its Compliance and Ethics Program and Quality of Care and Patient Safety Program (collectively, “Programs”) with an overall objective of sustaining the progress achieved during the CIA and positioning the health system for long-term success with robust, effective Programs;
